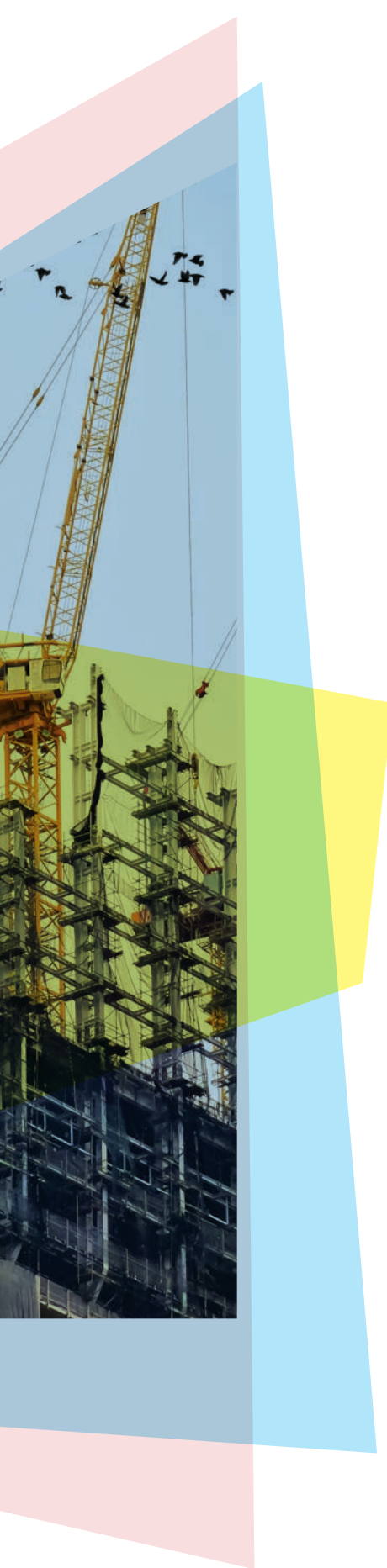

He was also appointed as Secretary to the ISO "Project" committee, for the development of the new standard ISO 45001, which is set to replace OHSAS 18001 in 2017.

David Smith has many years' experience developing, writing and implementing management systems and in particular, assessing HSE systems. He chairs a variety of BSI Committees including the committees responsible for management systems. Additionally, he represents the UK on ISO and CEN international committees on HSE management systems standards. He is Chair of ISO PC 283 (ISO 45001 committee on OHS). He has experience of risk, quality, OHS and environmental management in practice in large corporate organizations, government agencies as well as SME's. He undertakes consultancy, training and assessment work all over the world. David possesses a Bachelor of Science, London University, London, Master of Science, London University, London, Approved Lead Audit Trainer for IMS, OHS.
